PJ pleaded with us to be in the annual BLC parade, so we borrowed a trumpet and flute from the school music room for our 2 kids to play. Elvie and I carried the school banner at the head of the parade while the 500 BLC students and staff marched in their colorful uniforms behind us, complete with majorettes, drums and lyres, for the one-mile trek around the neighborhood of the school. Followed by BLC's 7 blue buses, neighborhood children cheered from their homes as we passed by with colorful balloons. Arriving at the outdoor basketball court, I prayed for and challenged the kids for their two days of sports competitions. "Who was the strongest man in the Bible, besides Jesus?" A girl from the blue team cried out, "Samson!" Now his strength did not come from his muscles, nor from his money, and not even from his good looks. His strength came from God.

The second day of our competitions, in oppressive tropical humidity and sweat, we ran in three races.
