For support of those at ages 2 through 15, the fee is \$25 (P1250) per month.

Each Sponsorship covers the following: tuition, enrollment, books, registration, dental checkup, insurance, medical checkup, ID card, instructional materials, PTA & library & campus fees, school publications, graduation fee & gown, field trip transportation costs, boy/girl scout membership & uniforms, gym fee, and basic school supplies (notebooks, pencils, etc.).

#### GOD DIRECTS...AND REDIRECTS

"Who will care for the babies?"

Often God touches the heart of a believer to leave his/her own country and become missionary here in Davao City. Mark and his wife Maryann are one such couple.

They began work with BLC and one of our church plants, helping desperate children from the streets, but they quickly ran into some snags in the process. They tried to partner with another ministry, "Sparrow's Gate", which caters to the needs of street children, but they found that their goals were not compatible. Sparrow's Gate wants to help older children on the streets, while Mark and Mary Ann want to help poor infants and young children.

After trying the mission for older children, it was more than Mary Ann could handle. Older children who lack discipline can get rude, shouting at and cursing adults...even running away. She gave it a valiant effort, but it was just too much.

After much prayer and soul searching, they parted ways with Sparrows Gate in order to help younger children. Thus, they will soon be moving out of the FHF house, since it was purchased by Sparrow's Gate funds.

They are still with Father's House Foundation for Street Children and Other Children at Risk (FHF), as well as our church and BLC, with a goal to help the homeless and destitute kids of Davao through both spiritual and physical aid. Thanks to FHF, the home purchased by Sparrow's Gate will still be put to its intended good use, and Mark will be pushing forward with their own work at the same time.

They want to develop their own facility, under the umbrella of the FHF and BLC. In the meantime, they continue to serve the needy children of Davao. Learning from their work with the poor families of their own church , they found that many young children are left at home alone during the day, sometimes as long as 12 hours, with no supervision. Poor parents must work or face starvation.

These families cannot afford childcare. Young children who lack supervision are often a danger to themselves. The meager pay the parents bring home is insufficient to feed their families, and it is the youngest -- especially infants, who suffer the most. With no money for formula and insufficient nutrition to support breast feeding, it is no wonder the Philippines faces such a high infant mortality rate. They now give free daytime child care for the kids of the working poor. focusing on kids from birth to 4 years of age. Praise God for these flexible missionaries!

This will allow the parents to focus on their work so that they can keep them fed and healthy.

BLC hosted, with Kiwanis, Lions, Boy Scouts & Davao Churches, an all-day CPR/BLS (Basic Life Support) Seminar.

Raindrops sprinkled on my windshield as I drove to the Red Cross to pick up our 2 instructors, with their practice dummies. Meanwhile my friends were "swimming in the rain" thru our corner of the Ocean.

"Myocardial infarction is the medical term for a heart attack" shared Timatai, our Red Cross rep, a few hours later. June (her assistant) joined in. "Cerebrovascular accident is a stroke."

Later, the 89 delegates to the seminar laughed as our BLC handyman tried kissing the dummy during the practice mouth-to-mouth resuscitation exercise.

Next week, as my buddy Stax, told me how the swim went, I clutched my CPR certificate, thinking, "It's ok. Now Davao is safer with 89 new rescuers!"
