For support of those at ages 4 through 15, the fee is \$25 (P1050) per month.

Each Sponsorship covers the following: tuition, enrollment, books, registration, dental checkup, insurance, medical checkup, ID card, instructional materials, PTA & library & campus fees, school publications, graduation fee & gown, field trip transportation costs, boy/girl scout membership & uniforms, gym fee, and basic school supplies (notebooks, pencils, etc.).

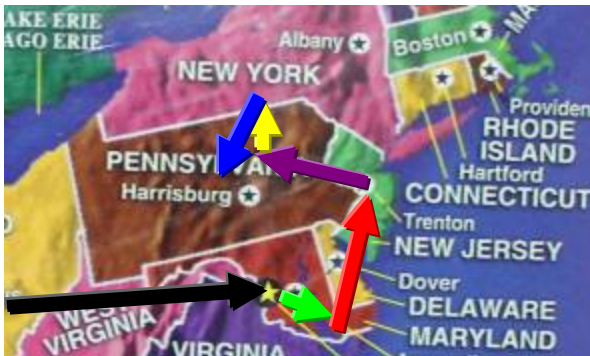
BCA'S K-KIDS: SMILING DELEGATES

At the 36th Annual Convention of the Kiwanis Clubs of the Philippine South District, the brand new K-Kids club of BCA was introduced.

Philippine Visayas and Mindanao Islands stood and applauded. Cameras flashed from around the auditorium as some of our "K-Kids" carried their banner down the aisle.

The true applause goes to the Convention Delegates. It was they who had provided access for our malnourished students to have weekly feedings of vitamin-fortified rice, as well as de-worming.

Other clubs worldwide had donated toothbrushes and toothpaste so that the kids would still have teeth to chew the rice with!

But the gift of toothbrushes once a year was not enough. We needed more. American VBS kids donated hundreds more toothbrushes. But still, after three months the paste and brushes both wore out. How could we make the strength of the kids' teeth a sustainable project, so that the kids could chew their fortified rice?

Often as we work among the poor, we are overwhelmed by their unending needs. While we want to meet all their needs, we must listen to God's voice as He points the way to help here and there, where we can.

A month after PJ and I spoke at a morning men's prayer meeting in New York, their teacher emailed me. "Paul, we decided to take on your toothbrush project!"

How awesome that this need, the healthy teeth of these poor kids, has been shared by the teamwork of Kiwanians, VBSes, and even a men's group!

So, as the BCA kids walked down the aisle of the convention hall, their smiles glistened in the light of flash pictures, reflecting God's provision in so very many ways!

JUN-AUG 2011 SOUHEASTERN USA SPEAKING TOUR



JUNE 10-19 MARYLAND-PENNSYLVANIA

After speaking in Utah, we flew to Maryland, rented a car and drove to a sponsor's home to stay overnight. Their three kids painted t-shirts for my upcoming race (*pic 2*). We also leaped on their backyard trampoline with them (*pic 3*)! After driving to the Ironman race (two hours away) and registering, we slept overnight in a local church (*pic 4*). I then competed over seven hours in the next day's triathlon race (*pic 1*), then we drove up to New Jersey, where a sponsor there (who happens to be a piano

teacher) gave free lessons to PJ and Abby (*pic 5*). After stopping to talk with a few of the pastors in a sponsoring local church (*pic 6*) we headed up to Shamokin Dam, PA to speak at their prayer meeting (*pic 7*). Stopping by our family homestead, PJ rode down a hill in the century-old wooden wagon (*pic 8*). Driving up to my uncle's funeral in NY, I shared how he sponsored a child in our school (*pic 9*). On the way back to PA, the van broke down (*pic 10*).

The next day I shared about our ministry at our

Family reunion (*pic 11*). The next day I spoke at the outdoor worship service of a church (*pic 12*), among whose congregation are many who sponsor BLC kids (including the pastor). Elvie and the kids set up a display table of Philippine artifacts, as well as cards explaining how to sponsor poor Filipinos at Barner Learning Center (*pic 13*).

A: While school is only ten months long in the Philippines, Barner Christian Academy holds classes every month of the year. This way the poor children can catch up with the aptitude of more financially fortunate students.
