SIX-HOUR WEEKLY SUNDAY KIDS CHAPEL III

Hundreds of small children arrive bright and early in anticipation every Sunday morning at Barner Christian Academy in Davao City, Philippines.

Four classrooms hold the kids as teachers travel from class to class. As I preach to the parents in the gym, Inday teaches her class Christian songs, which the kids will perform during the closing chapel, on the last Sunday of the month during the adult worship service.

Next, Abigail leads her class in Bible verse memorization. Word by word, she leads the kids till they know the verses.

A parent rings the bell every forty minutes so the teachers know when to

switch classrooms. Richard tells a Bible story. He always makes sure that the kids participate in the story with motions and questions.

PJ challenges his classes with quiz questions like, "Who built the ark?" Since he is a very gifted artist, he'll draw hints on the blackboard with chalk.

After a hearty meal, the kids will join in their own worship service in the gym, complete with puppets by PJ and Abigail.

The kids always help lead in the kids' chapel. Time flies and nobody seems to notice as the hours fly by.

During missions month (November), the kids waved flags from countries to pray for.







JUN-AUG 2011 SOUHEASTERN USA SPEAKING TOUR

JULY 3-14 FLORIDA TO MICHIGAN



Just over a month into our furlough, we had prayer with two Florida sponsor families. After church in Orlando and a luncheon with Filipino Americans, we celebrated the fourth of July with fifty nuggets of chicken at McDonalds!

Sending a box of clothes to the Philippines, we then headed on to Alabama. There we spoke in two Bible studies, a Kiwanis club and at church. Of course we took a dip in the ocean too!

After friends in Alabama replaced our van's destroyed fuel pump, we drove through the night, and had lunch the next day with a sponsor in Tennessee. Then on through another day and night to West Virginia. We spoke at a TOPS (Taking off Pounds) club, as well as two worship services and a youth group. Four new sponsors!

The pastor in West Virginia let us use his computer to contact the Philippines via Skype to get details on a tragedy that occurred at the school.

After driving 300 miles and sending another huge box of toys (which we got at Salvation Army, and from churches) to the Philippine children, the van broke down and was repaired for free by a generous mechanic. We stayed overnight with a friend who sponsors four children at BCA.

My brother Tim in Ohio brought us to the park

with friends who'd driven out eight hours from Indiana to see us. After visiting another sponsor in Ohio, we headed up to Michigan.

There, we shared with a doctor, while riding her boat, about an idea a lawyer friend had, called "Oinkers". This ministry would provide pigs for poor families to grow, asking only that they give in return one piglet out of each litter, for other families to grow.
