<u>A RECENT EMAIL FROM A DEAR FELLOW MISSIONARY:</u> Hi Paul and Evie, I had a question. You mentioned "While our preschoolers were receiving their certificates at BCA, their fellow elementary and high school sponsored children were receiving their diplomas at BCA's sister schools all throughout Davao City." Does the BCA campus only have preschool? Do other sponsored children actually attend other schools? Are they Christian schools? –Mary

<u>MY RESPONSE</u>: Dear Mary, Regarding our "sister schools," this is the scenario that began in 2008 when our secretary made a few major mistakes on our annual permit renewal. She was not found out until two years later, at which time the government demanded that we restrict our operations to only educating preschoolers until we purchase a larger property. Their reasoning behind this was that, although the larger property had always been a requirement, the government had made an exception in our case, since we are an institution of such high integrity, schooling the poor without cost. That integrity was damaged with the secretary's mistake. We decided that, in order to still provide schooling for the elementary-aged children, we would team up with other schools. Problem was, there were not enough Christian schools to educate all of these kids. Plus many of those schools had outrageously high tuition rates which our sponsorship program could not possibly consider. Then came our decision to place the spiritual nurture of these poor families under local pastors who had the responsibility of small churches. While paying all of the expenses of the children attending public schools (which are not free), we are assured that the local pastors (eight of them) are spiritually nurturing these families. The pastors are pleased, as they now have congregations to be responsible for. Previously their congregations only amounted to a small handful. After we build our new campus in 2017, all our students will be under one roof once again."
