For support of those from ages 4 through 18, the fee is \$25 (P1050) per month.

Each Sponsorship covers the following: tuition, enrollment, books, registration, dental checkup, insurance, medical checkup, ID card, instructional materials, PTA & library & campus fees, school publications, graduation fee & gown, field trip transportation costs, boy/girl scout membership & uniforms, gym fee, and basic school supplies (notebooks, pencils, etc.).

YET AS THE WORLD BECOMES SMALLER THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEDIA, EVANGELISM AND INTERNET, THIS ARCHIPELAGO OF OVER SEVEN THOUSAND ISLANDS IS SPEEDILY ADAPTING TO GLOBAL TRENDS. THE PHILIPPINE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DESIRES THAT AS THESE CHANGES OCCUR, THE NEW GENERATIONS OF YOUNG AN IMPRESSIONABLE FILIPINO CHILDREN WILL NOT FORGET THEIR DELIGHTFULLY DIVERSE HISTORICAL HERITAGE OF COLORFUL COSTUMES, TRIBAL DANCES AND DIALECTS. DANCES. EACH CLASS HAS BEEN TRAINING FOR MONTHS UNDER THE CAREFUL DIRECTION OF ITS TEACHER. WHILE ALL OF THE KIDS ARE CHARMING, TWO VERY SPECIAL PUPILS SHINE ESPECIALLY BRIGHTLY. ONE HAS A LEG EIGHT INCHES SHORTER THAN THE OTHER, YET HER



INTRICATELY-PRESENTED PERFORMANCE IS ACCOMPANIED NOT ONLY BY HER OWN BRIGHT SMILE, BUT THOSE OF THE AUDIENCE AS WELL. ANOTHER CHILD HAS HAIR THAT HAS BEEN TIED TO STICK STRAIGHT UP ELEVEN INCHES IN THE AIR! NEXT SOME OF THE TEACHERS IN NATIVE DRESS ACCOMPANY THEIR STUDENTS ON STAGE. THEN THE BCA FACULTY AND STAFF SING, FOLLOWED BY "BEST COSTUME"



AWARDS, AND A HANDSHAKE FROM THE PRESIDENT (ME). AFTER A GROUP PICTURE (MANY BY PROUD DADS & MOMS TOO), NATIVE FOODS ARE CONSUMED. THE ENTIRE STUDENT BODY GOES HOME EARLY FOR LONG WEEKEND.
