

SINCE OUR FAMILY'S RETURN TO THE PHILIPPINES IN AUGUST, EVERY MONTH HAS BROUGHT NATIONAL CALAMITIES. AUGUST SAW SEVERE FLOODING THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, SEPTEMBER BROUGHT TYPHOON ODETTE & A WAR IN ZAMBOANGA. THEN OCTOBER BROUGHT A MAJOR 8.2-LEVEL EARTHQUAKE. BEGINNING ON HALLOWEEN, 3 MASSIVE TYPHOONS HIT, JUST A WEEK APART FROM EACH OTHER. THE FIRST, NAMELESS TYPHOON DID MASSIVE DAMAGE TO OUR BCA CAMPUS WITH SIX-FOOT-DEEP MUDDY WATERS IN A SURGING FLASH FLOOD WHICH DESTROYED SCHOOL BUSES, CARS (MANY ENTIRELY SUBMERGED), DOORS, BOOKS AND PAPERS, AS WELL AS SMEARING THICK, PASTY MUD OVER FLOORS, WALLS AND FURNITURE. CHAIRS AND HUGE CABINETS WERE TORN UP BY THE MERCILESS TORRENTS OF WATER AND HURLED THROUGH 2-INCH-THICK LOCKED, SOLID WOOD CLASSROOM DOORS, SHATTERING THEM OFF THEIR HINGES LIKE TOOTHPICKS. A WEEK LATER TYPHOON YOLANDA HIT. OTHERWISE KNOWN INTERNATIONALLY AS "HAIYAN" WITH 195 MPH WINDS, YOLANDA WHIPPED UP A THIRTY-FOOT TSUNAMI, THE MOST POWERFUL TYPHOON IN THE 6,000 YEAR RECORDED HISTORY OF PLANET EARTH. PORTIONS OF BCA'S ROOF & SCHOOL SIGN WERE TORN AWAY BY THE WINDS, AND HUGE CARGO SHIPS FARTHER NORTH OF US IN THE CITIES OF TACLOBAN, ORMOC, GUIUAN AND LEYTE WERE LIFTED UP AND PLUNGED ONTO HOMES HALF A MILE INLAND FROM THE SHORE. OVER FIVE THOUSAND DIED, MILLIONS WERE HOMELESS. THEN THE VERY NEXT WEEK, TYPHOON ZORAIDA HIT, ADDING INSULT TO INJURY AND FINISHING OUT THE TYPHOON ALPHABET WITH A BANG.

COASTAL FISHING VILLAGES HAD BEEN WASHED INTO THE PACIFIC. MEANWHILE, THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING IN NEW YORK LIGHTED UP THE PHILIPPINE FLAG COLORS HONORING THE FILIPINO PEOPLE'S RESILLIENCE AMIDST CATASTROPHES. AT BCA, WE LINED THE MUDDY FLOOR WITH CARDBOARD TO KEEP FROM SLIPPING, & DISCARDED 100 TRASH BAGS OF BOOKS, PAPERS, & REFUSE. AROUND THE CLOCK WE FED VOLUNTEER



WORK TEAMS OF 60 DAILY. I PREACHED TO THE CONGREGATION TO LOOK BEYOND OUR DAMAGE & HELP OTHERS. MOVING OUR PRAYER MEETING UP TO BCA'S DRY 3<sup>RD</sup>-FLOOR LIBRARY, WE SOUGHT THE LORD'S GUIDANCE & ARE FILLING UP A C-130 HELICOPTER/CONVERSION PLANE TO CARRY AID AND FILIPINOS TO ASSIST LOCAL PASTORS IN REMOTE TERRORIST-RIDDEN AREAS WHERE INTERNATIONAL MILITARY CANNOT REACH. PTL!
