**International BCA Sponsorships
(801-BLC):**

The BCA (Barner Christian Academy) International Student Sponsorship Program is an opportunity for Filipino children who otherwise might not be able to afford a Quality Christian Education to obtain schooling at no cost to their families through the "adoption" of their financial schooling obligations by international supporters. For support of those from ages 4 through 18, the fee is \$25 (P1050) per month.

Each Sponsorship covers the following: tuition, enrollment, books, registration, dental checkup, insurance, medical checkup, ID card, instructional materials, PTA & library & campus fees, school publications, graduation fee & gown, field trip transportation costs, boy/girl scout membership & uniforms, gym fee, and basic school supplies (notebooks, pencils, etc.).

Please pray: for the "other two months" of the school year between commencement and enrollment: BCA requires 12 months of schooling including Vacation Bible school in April and Summer School each May.

Praise God: That the Philippine government has already issued (in March) the annual permit for operation of the Barner Christian Academy for the school year 2014-2015. In years past they were sometimes delayed until the first month of classes had already begun.

FAQ: (Frequently Asked Question):

Q: Is your family going to Israel in July, 2014?

A: Yes. Over the years sponsors have voluntarily added to our family's "get away fund" and we've finally saved up enough to take our "once in a lifetime" vacation. We'll assist local missions and also baptize our kids in the Jordan River.
