

FIGURE 5: PIE CHART OF GRADE LEVELS OF 21 CASE STUDIES

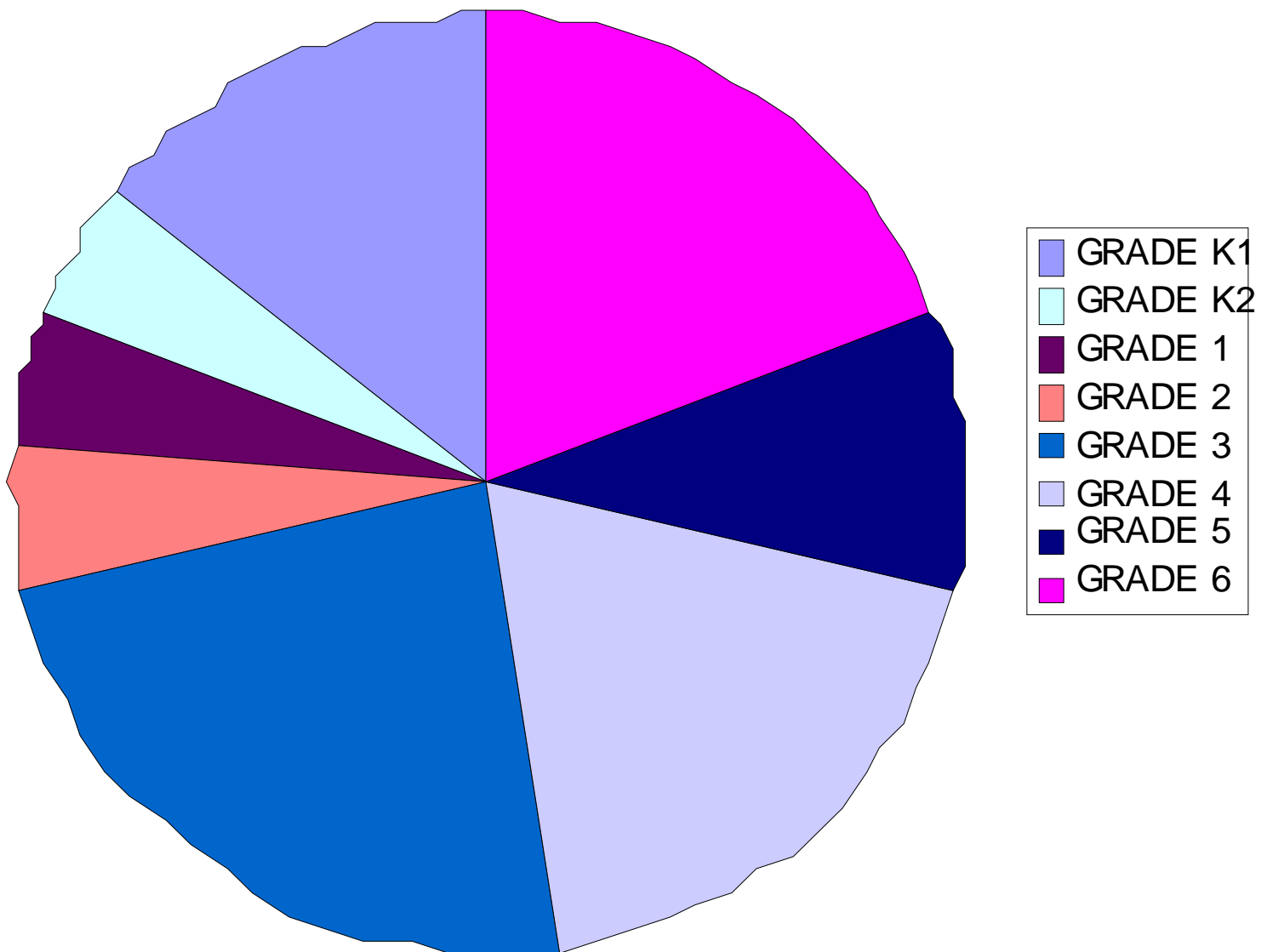


FIGURE 5: PIE CHART OF GRADE LEVELS

The grade levels of the 21 children are: K1:3,K2:1,1:1,2:1,**3:5,4:4,5:2,6:4**. Those in **Bold typeface** represent the mode. This Pie Chart represents those with the highest incidence of discipline problems to be in grades 3, 4 and 6. Therefore these three grades present the highest incidence of CARR. Since the younger grades (K1 & 2, and elementary grades 1-3) present a lesser number of incidence of high CARR, they have a more balanced lifestyle. Of particular interest however is that K1 has a relatively high incidence of CARR, although lower than the mode. Therefore BLC can impose stronger emphasis of its interventions on this grade level (K1) to forestall future increased CARR.
